
I. Tools Required

½" Drive Socket Wrench with 3" Extension, socket set, ½" Drive Torque Wrench and a wrench set.

III. Included Hardware



IV. Removal of OEM tow hooks (if applicable)

- 1. From underneath the driver side of the vehicle, remove the driver side OEM tow hook using a socket wrench.
 - a) The OEM tow hooks are mounted using three (3) bolts. These bolts mount to the frame of the vehicle in a triangular pattern.
 - b) Remove the nuts and bolts that support the tow hook.
 - c) Slide the tow hook and remove from the vehicle.
- 2. Repeat the preceding steps to remove the passenger side OEM tow hook.

V. Installation of Fab Fours Winch Mount

- 1. Review the exploded parts view above
- 2. Install the two Tow hooks on to the winch mount using the hardware provided.
- 3. Torque the Tow Hook Mounting bolts to 106 Foot-Pounds.
- 4. Install the small frame winch (Customer Supplied)
- 5. With the aid of a lifting device or additional helpers, lift the winch mount and position it so that the rear tongues align with the holes in the factory bumper.
- 6. Carefully slide the Winch mount through the factory bumper and line up with the holes on top of the frame.
- 7. Install the provided hardware through the frame on each side of the vehicle.
- 8. Hand Tighten the bolts through the frame and into the welded nuts located on the winch mount.
- 9. Torque all bolts to 106 Foot-Pounds.
