INSTALLATION TIPS:



STEP 1: Install four rubber bumpers [2] to the bottom of the storage box [1]. You may need a small screwdriver to push the bumpers [2] in place.

STEP 2: Lift up passenger seat.

STEP 3: Set the storage box [1] under the seat. Finish installation.
